H1N1 Vaccine: We have received two more shipments of vaccine over the past week—300 LAIV (nasal spray vaccine) and 200 doses in multi dose vials. We plan to hold vaccine clinics every Wednesday from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM in the Public Health offices in each county. Please check our website www.idahopublichealth.com for details about who we will vaccinate at these clinics each Wednesday.

At this Wednesday's clinic (October 28th), we will vaccinate

- **Pregnant women,**
- **Medically fragile children 6 months through 18 years of age,**
- **Family members living with babies less than 6 month of age,**
- **EMS Personnel**

The next step in our plan is to start vaccinating school age children in schools. We are working with the school districts to provide LAIV (nasal spray) vaccine clinics for children less than 10 years old; for those children with underlying health conditions who cannot receive LAIV, we will have a limited number of injectable vaccines in the school clinics. These clinics could start as soon as November 4th.
