(Note: students with special needs are being considered on an individual basis, and families will be contacted by case managers.)
- 3. Please email or call if your child or children will not be attending Moscow schools this fall.

COVID-19 Pandemic Task Force Information:

Documents and procedures are nearing completion by each subcommittee. These documents will be reviewed by the Oversight committee, and then sent to regional health officials for their review and approval. When these documents are completed, they will be located on our district's website (see website information below). Once this is complete a supplemental handbook will be provided to each family and be located on our website.

There have been many questions about how the school will respond when a positive COVID-19 case is identified. The MSD281 Health and Safety Committee is developing a guideline, with the assistance of the medical community and public health, which will detail the response to a positive COVID-19 case within our schools. A finalized plan will be released to all parents, students, and staff prior to the start of school. The committee feels thus far that the extensive work we are doing to modify schedules and reduce class sizes will enable us to minimize, as much as possible, school-wide closures and class disruptions when we do experience a positive COVID-19 case.
